Fire Hydrant Painting Contest Rules

- Hydrants are available on a first come, first serve basis, pending approval.
- The design should be appropriate for a public space and should not endorse an individual, business, be political in nature, or be offensive in any way. CHAINS CANNOT BE PAINTED
- Potential design themes include: Designs inspired by the work of famous artists; Designs with a whimsical or humorous twist that will make viewers smile. Context-sensitive designs that would uniquely connect a particular fire hydrant with its immediate surroundings. Colorful, abstract designs.
- The public and private space immediately around the fire hydrant should be kept clean and neat when not directly working on the fire hydrant. Please respect the property.
- Registration and selection runs through June 1, 2016. All payments must be made and proposed designs must be submitted for approval during this period. These can be submitted to City Hall in person or by mailing to Heritage Days Committee, 600 Portland Ave, St Paul Park, MN 55071. Selected applicants will be notified.
- Painting of fire hydrants will begin on July 1, 2016 and last through July 30, 2016.
- Only designated fire hydrants within the St Paul Park boundaries are potential candidates for painting.
- The Heritage Days Committee will provide brushes and paint for decorating the fire hydrants. Please contact Jennifer Cheesman at jcheesman@stpaulpark.org or Sandi Dingle at SandiDingle@metc.state.mn.us for instructions on paint/supplies pick up.
- Paint only on your assigned fire hydrant.
- You must use only the paint provided nothing can be attached to the fire hydrant.
- No words may be included.
- You may use stencils or freehand your design.
- You must stick to the design submitted in this application. If you desire to make changes, you must seek the Heritage Days Committee's approval prior to changing your design.
- If these rules are not followed your hydrant will be painted over. The Heritage Days Committee will not refund application fee in cases of not adhering to the rules of the program.
- Fire hydrants that fall into a state that no longer enhance the immediate area will be painted over. For example, a hydrant that begins to peel or otherwise deteriorate.

- The Heritage Days Committee will be basing their decision to approve applications based on creativity, originality, imagination, and appropriateness. People's Choice Awards will be decided by votes by the public based on pictures of the painted hydrant. Votes can be

- An entry Fee of \$10.00 per Fire Hydrant will be used towards next year's Heritage Day Festival. By participating in the Fire Hydrant Design Contest you acknowledge that the Heritage Days Committee, the City of St Paul Park and Washington County are not responsible in any way for any injury or property damage directly or indirectly associated with this contest.

- Cash prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place as well as one honorable mention.




